On behalf of the Scientific Committee, you are cordially invited to submit abstracts of 400 words for the following themes:

- Measuring and Monitoring of subsidence,
- Understanding subsidence Mechanisms,
- Modelling of subsidence (predictive and inverse),
- Impacts of subsidence,
- Measures and coping strategies: mitigation and adaptation.
- Studies, Monitoring and Observational Method

There is no specific format for the abstract, but it should contain

- 1. the paper title (max 30 words)
- 2. the names and affiliations of the authors (incl. contact data for the corresponding author)
- 3. a brief description of the work to be presented and the conference
- 4. theme(s) the work addresses.

The official language is English.

The Scientific Committee will review the abstracts to assess their relevance to the symposium, the originality of the work, and its potential contribution to engineering science or practice.
